3. Batch Metadata Editing





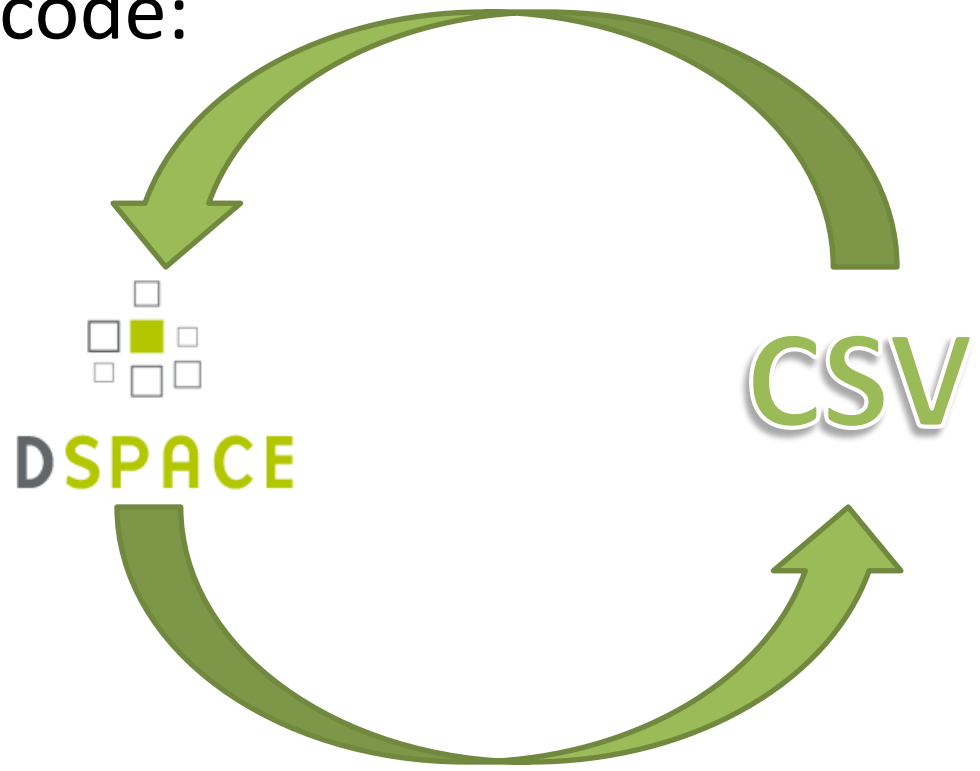
- Better statistics facility
